

ISENTRY COMMUNITY RULES

THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT AND MODIFICATION AND AMPLIFICATION AND ONLY PROVIDE A CORE SUMMARY OF PRINCIPLES

The following rules govern the Use and procedures for Use of the iSentry Products by Primary Member Users, Subscribers and Individual Users within the iSentry Global Community. These rules comprise part of the Primary Member User Documentation referred to in the relevant Primary Member User Agreement, the Subscriber Agreement and the Individual User Registration Licence, as the case may be, and as may be amended from time to time and are referred to as the **iSentry Community Rules**

In these rules a Primary Member User or Subscriber or Individual User is referred to as a **User**. Words and expressions used in these rules shall have the same meanings given to them in the General Conditions and Definitions of the Primary Member User Agreement, Subscriber Agreement and the Individual User Registration Licence, as the case may be.

Acceptable Use Policy Rules

Rule 1

User shall not use the iSentry Global Community for spamming.

Spamming includes, but is not limited to:

- (1) The bulk sending of unsolicited messages, or the sending of unsolicited e-mails which provoke complaints from recipients,
- (2) The sending of junk mail,
- (3) Excessive and repeated cross-posting,
- (4) Harassment of another User (s), including but not limited to, transmitting any threatening, libellous or obscene material, or material of any nature which could be deemed to be offensive

Rule 2

User shall not use the iSentry Service in a manner which violates any city, state, national or international law or regulation, or which fails to comply with accepted Internet protocol.

This includes any activity that could or might or would be regarded as criminal, whether or not indictable, or unlawful or irregular and includes espionage, surveillance, terrorism or civic unrest, fraud, theft and tax evasion.

Rule 3

Subscriber shall not attempt to interfere in any way with iSentry's networks or network security, or attempt to use the iSentry Global Community to gain unauthorized access to any other computer system.

Rule 4

User shall at all times provide iSentry with accurate and relevant KYC information for the purposes of inception of any iSentry account or Use of the iSentry Global Community

Rule 5

User shall immediately notify iSentry of any security breach in or unauthorized use of User's account.

User shall not interfere in any way with another User's Use of, or iSentry's provision of, the iSentry Products.

Rule 6

User shall not resell, rent, lease, grant a security interest in, or make commercial use of the iSentry Products without the express written consent of iSentry.

Rule 7

User is fully responsible for the contents of his/her transmissions through the iSentry Service.

The iSentry Global Community simply acts as a passive conduit for the User to send and receive secure information of the User's own choosing. However, iSentry reserves the right to take any action with respect to the iSentry Global Community that iSentry deems necessary or appropriate (in its sole discretion) if iSentry believes the User, or the User's information may create liability for iSentry, compromise or disrupt the iSentry Global Community or other Users, or cause iSentry to lose (in whole or in part) the services of iSentry's internet service providers or other suppliers through or with whom the iSentry Global Community is sustained.

Rule 8

User takes responsibility for its own Use of the iSentry Global Community and the storage of any documents or messages

Sentry assumes no responsibility for the deletion or failure to store, deliver or timely deliver messages or documents. Without limiting the foregoing sentence, iSentry may, from time to time and without notice, set limit(s) on the number of messages or documents a member may send, store, or receive through the iSentry Global Community, and iSentry retains the right to delete any messages or documents above or below such limit(s) as well as to deactivate any account which is over such limit(s) without any liability whatsoever, and User hereby releases iSentry from any such liability. Any notice provided by iSentry to User in connection with such limit(s) shall not create any obligation to provide future notification regarding any change(s) to such limit(s).
